

MyDuitStory 6.0 Short Video Competition

- Terms and Conditions

1. Introduction

MyDuitStory 6.0 Short Video Competition (Competition) is a financial education initiative by Financial Education Network (FEN)¹. The Competition aims to raise awareness of FOMO (Fear of Missing Out) and JOMO (Joy of Missing Out) and how these behaviours affect financial management among youth.

2. Eligibility

The Competition is open to all Malaysian students aged 18-30 from public and private higher learning institutions (universities, polytechnics and community colleges) under the Ministry of Higher Education, *Institusi Pendidikan Guru Malaysia under Ministry of Education*, TVET institutions under the National TVET Council² including *Institusi Latihan Kemahiran Belia dan Sukan (ILKBS)* under the Ministry of Youth and Sports, as well as TVET and MARA institutions under the Ministry of Rural and Regional Development (KKDW).

3. Registration

- a) Students may submit an individual entry OR as a team of not more than 4 members (including Team Leader but excluding talents).
- b) Students are required to register at <https://www.fenetwork.my/myduitstory> by providing the following details:
 - i. Name (Individual/Team Leader), e-mail address, contact number and name of the university/institute represented by the Individual/Team Leader.
 - ii. Upon registration, the Individual/Team Leader will receive a confirmation e-mail which include:
 - ✓ a link to a Google Form for the Individual/Team Leader to fill in the details of the Lecturer(s) and the Team, if applicable.
 - ✓ Facebook link to the Virtual Briefing by Bank Negara Malaysia and The National Film Development Corporation Malaysia (FINAS) .
- c) Team Members can be from the same or different participating universities/institutes.
- d) The Organiser reserves the right to validate the status of the students.
- e) Students may submit multiple entries, but only one entry could be considered to the final round.

4. Important Dates

- c) Video submissions: **20 April 2026 – 8 June 2026, 11:59 p.m.**

5. Video Submission

- a) Students must upload the **video** to their respective YouTube accounts and ensure that **the video is "Unlisted"**.
- b) Students to invite myduitstory@fenetwork.my to view the YouTube video.
- c) The videos uploaded on YouTube must include a title and a brief synopsis of up to 300 words (in English or Bahasa Melayu).
- d) Include the YouTube video link in your entry submission. Ensure that the name, email, and phone number used for the submission match the details you registered with
 - i. **E-mail Subject:** MyDuitStory 6.0 Submission | Individual/Team Name | University/Institutes (Compulsory)
 - ii. Provide the **link to the video uploaded on YouTube**.
 - iii. Indicate the **title of the video**.

6. Coverage

Students are required to create an inspiring and educational video that explains how FOMO and JOMO influence financial management among youth covering areas such as the following:

a) Awareness of FOMO and JOMO

- Define FOMO and JOMO
- Explain their relevance to today's digital spending habits and how they affect youth financially and emotionally.

b) Impact of FOMO on Financial Behaviour

- Highlight how FOMO drives impulsive online shopping, overspending, and social-pressure-driven purchases.
- Explain the risks associated with FOMO, including rising debt, financial anxiety and overuse of "easy" payment options such as Buy Now, Pay Later (BNPL)

c) Benefits of Practising JOMO

- Illustrate how embracing JOMO promotes mindful spending, reduced financial stress, and improved self-control.
- Showcase how redirecting impulse spending toward positive financial habits such as building an emergency fund, regular savings, or long-term investments can help youth benefit from the power of compounding.

d) Practical Financial Tips for Youth

- Provide actionable guidance on managing FOMO and JOMO wisely, for example:
 - Setting personal spending limits
 - Prioritising needs over wants
 - Avoiding impulsive purchases triggered by social media
 - Understanding the true cost behind “easy” digital payment options (BNPL, instalment plans, etc.)

e) Real-Life Scenarios and Examples

- Use relatable, youth-centric scenarios such as resisting the urge to buy the latest gadget or skipping unnecessary flash sales or online promotions
- Demonstrate how conscious spending choices lead to better financial outcomes, such as achieving savings goals or enhancing long-term financial stability.

7. Video Format

- a) **Duration:** Between 3 to 5 minutes, including the title.
- b) **Format:** High-definition MP4 format. The aspect ratio should be 16:9 and a minimum resolution of HD (1920 X 1080 px).
- c) **Style:** Documentary, narrative (scripted), short drama, animation, or anything suitable to deliver the story on FOMO vs JOMO.

8. Video Requirements

- a) The video can be either in English, Bahasa Melayu, or a mix of both languages.
- b) The video has not been submitted to any other competitions.
- c) All entries must be the students' original works, and no part or component thereof is copied from any other work or material.
- d) The video must not include any endorsements of products or services.
- e) The video must not contain any obscene, violent, racist, religious, political and defamatory content.
- f) Students shall fully bear all costs and expenses for the production of the video and their participation in the Competition.

9. Judging criteria

a) Main Theme Message (40 points)

i. Presentation

Does the video clearly communicate the concepts of FOMO and JOMO,

highlight the risks of FOMO-driven impulsive spending, and promote JOMO as a healthier and more mindful financial approach? Does it provide practical tips on responsible digital payments and conscious spending, supported by relatable real-life scenarios that demonstrate how better financial decisions lead to positive outcomes? Does the video present these messages in a cohesive, engaging, and emotionally impactful way to reinforce the importance of smart financial management among youth.

ii. **Effectiveness of messages to be conveyed**

Are the key messages clearly identified? Does the video clearly depict the key messages? Are the messages sent effectively? How compelling is the video?

iii. **Making an impact towards change**

Does the video create a viewer's desire to make a change, spread the message further, or provide a call to action?

b) Creativity/Originality (30 points)

Videos must be students' work, in students' own words, and may include personal experiences and thoughtful observations. Videos must reflect that students have carefully examined and thought through the topics on 'FOMO vs JOMO'.

i. **Originality** - uniqueness, and originality of the story.

ii. **Creativity** - effective use of imagination and creativity.

iii. **Plot** - actions, events, conflicts, and turning points that propel the story forward. How the story unfolds.

iv. **Pacing and Structure** - the timing of the action, unfolding of plot elements, character development, and the video's framework.

v. **Characters** - personalities that are distinctive and compelling. A protagonist and antagonist with clear and active goals.

vi. **Entertainment Value** - Does the story keep the viewer's attention? Is it fun, engaging, or thought-provoking?

- vii. **Dialogue** – voices that are natural, concise, and unique to each character. Use of language that effectively reveals character and moves the story forward or the lack of dialogue is used effectively.

c) Technical Organisation (30 points)

How well is the video produced in terms of continuity, timing, camera operation, sound quality, editing, and adherence to the time limit of 3 - 5 minutes?

- i. **Videography** - the quality of videography demonstrated in work.
- ii. **Sound Quality** - the dialogues are clear and not hindered by any noise or music score.
- iii. **Music Score** - the music score is suited to the video and helps to tell the story and its characters

10. People's Choice – Most 'Likes'

- a) Shortlisted videos will be announced on Financial Education Network (FEN)'s Facebook, TikTok, and YouTube channels.
- b) The videos will be ranked based on the number of 'Likes'.
- c) Digital buy is **NOT** allowed to boost video promotion on social media. Entries found to have digital buy will be disqualified.

11. Prizes and Announcement of Winners

- 1st Prize: RM8,000 cash
 - 2nd Prize: RM5,000 cash
 - 3rd Prize: RM3,000 cash
 - Consolation Prizes: RM1,000 cash X 10
 - University/Institutes with Most Entries Submitted²: RM5,000 cash X 1
 - People's Choice (Most 'Likes'): RM2,000 cash
- a) The winners will be notified either by phone, e-mail, and published in FEN website, Facebook, Instagram and TikTok.
 - b) Cash prizes will be credited into an account of the individual/one of the team members (including Team Leader). Winners will be required to provide the account details for the purpose of transferring the prizes money.

12. Copyright and Ownership

- a) **Rights of the Organiser and Collaborators:** The winning entries shall grant the Organiser and Collaborators exclusive rights to use the submitted entries for educational and promotional purposes. Students further agree that the Organiser and Collaborators reserve the right to use their names in connection with such uses, but shall have no obligation to do so. The Organiser and Collaborators also reserve the right to modify or extend dates, or to cancel the Competition due to unforeseen circumstances.

- b) **Copyright:** By entering the Competition, students confirm that they are the rightful owners or otherwise have the necessary intellectual property rights to submit such materials, and warrant that they have obtained the rights to incorporate any copyrighted materials, including but not limited to music, soundtracks, audio, graphics, images, and video clips used in their video entry. Each entry, in whole or in part, must not infringe or violate any laws or the rights of any third party at any time.
- c) By submitting your entries for this Competition, all students agree and acknowledge that all intellectual property rights shall be owned by the Organiser. The Organiser shall have the exclusive right to use, edit, modify and publish the entry submitted by all the students, publish the names of the Students, in any way it deems fit for any advertising, trade, promotional purpose and for any other reason whatsoever, without any further notice to the students and the students shall not claim ownership or any payment or compensation on the materials. For the avoidance of doubt, the submissions will not be edited for judging purposes.
- d) **Consent for Castings:** Students shall inform casting talents featured in their entries of the possibility of the usage of the video entry by the Organiser. This is to avoid any royalty or compensation issues regarding the usage of the video entry by the Organiser in the future.
- e) **Limitations on Liability:** The Organiser hereby disclaims all liabilities that may arise in connection with the Competition entries. Further, the Organiser shall not be held responsible for any lost or damaged entries in transit. Entries are automatically rejected if they are incomplete, unreadable, damaged, not in compliance with the Competition Terms and Conditions stated herein or may bring the Competition into disrepute. The Organiser reserves the right to cancel, terminate, modify, suspend or extend the Competition at any point of time. The Organiser reserves the right to refuse or cancel any video screening, which is of insufficient quality to ensure satisfactory public screening. The decision of Organiser in all matters relating to the Competition shall be final and binding.

13. Personal Data Protection Act

- a) Students agree that personal data, including their names and contact details, provided to the Organiser will be recorded, stored, and otherwise processed for the administration of the Competition, as well as for related advertising, publicity, and other legitimate business purposes.
- b) Any personal data submitted in paragraph 13(a) may be disclosed to FEN members as permitted by the Personal Data Protection Act 2010.
- c) Request for access to or correction of the personal data or limit the processing of the personal data at any time hereafter can be done by submitting such request to the Organiser via e-mail myduitstory@fenetwork.my. By submitting the personal data via the Competition website, it is deemed that the Organiser has obtained consent to the processing and transfer (if required) of the personal data.
